Park Description

Aberkinsey Caravan Park is situated in the small village of Dyserth, just off the North Wales Coast, near Prestatyn. The park is small, quiet and family friendly, perfect for those who are looking for a holiday park for tranquillity and serenity.

Dyserth lies near St Asaph in rural Denbighshire, North Wales. It is bordered by Meliden to the north, Cwm to the south east, Trelawnyd to the east and Rhuddlan to the west. Nearby towns and villages include Prestatyn, Rhyl, Rhuddlan, Denbigh, Bodelwyddan, Abergele and Whitford.

The main landmark in Dyserth is the waterfall. The river Ffyddion, a tributary of the river Clwyd, flows through the village and falls over a 70ft ledge, creating the mesmerising waterfall.
