Park Description

Madryn Castle Holiday Home Park is a 5* award winning park, offering the perfect blend of serenity, seclusion and the spirit of adventure. The park is nestled in the heart of the Llŷn Peninsula, among peaceful natural woodland and rural green meadows, yet within easy reach of the nearby coastal towns of Abersoch, Nefyn and Pwllheli. From its perch on the hillside of Garnfadryn, it showcases panoramic views towards the coast and Snowdonia mountain range. Its gentle and rustic charm mimics the rugged, yet breath-taking landscapes that comprise the Llŷn Peninsula.

The park is steeped in history, once part of a large manor estate, built in the 19th century by local nobility who went on to colonise Puerto Madryn in Argentina. The castle stood on the grounds for over a century, before it was destroyed by a fire in the 1960's. Parts of the old castle can still be seen at the park today, with the castle's original gatehouse being restored to its former glory in 2011. The iconic gatehouse now serves as the park's main office, reminding visitors of the fascinating history with each visit.
